I have thoroughly reviewed the materials we received from you on June 22, 2007. I have also reviewed the court docket and the November 3, 2004 Memorandum and Order in the case you filed in the federal court in Knoxville, Case No.3:04-cv-00165 regarding certain of the events in question. In addition, I reviewed our disciplinary database regarding the attorneys against whom you have raised ethical concerns, as well as our files related to the prior complaints you have made regarding issues related to your son.

While Michael's untimely death was quite tragic, it is my conclusion that your allegations have been fully investigated in the past and I decline to reopen the investigation.

If there are any of the materials that you have sent me that you wish to have returned to you, please send me a letter itemizing what you would like to have back and I will see that they are returned.
